THE 24 HOUR PLAYS® bring together creative communities to produce plays and musicals that are written, rehearsed, and performed in 24 hours.

Flagship events include The 24 Hour Plays on Broadway and The 24 Hour Musicals, as well as productions in New York City London, Los Angeles, Dublin, Minneapolis, San Francisco, Germany, Athens, Finland, Mexico City, Florence, Denmark and more. Since March 2020, The 24 Hour Plays: Viral Monologues have generated over 600 new free-to-view theater pieces that have been viewed millions of times.

Each summer, The 24 Hour Plays: Nationals bring together the best early-career actors, directors, playwrights, producers and composers for a free professional intensive that has introduced audiences and collaborators to the next generation of artists who are changing the game in theater, television and film. Partner organizations have produced their own productions of The 24 Hour Plays in regional and professional theaters, colleges and universities, and just about everywhere you can find a curtain and a stage, reaching everyone from celebrities to students.

THE 24 HOUR PLAYS PROCESS

The 24 Hour Plays are an intensive theatrical endeavor in which artists write, direct, and perform six original short plays within 24 hours. The 24 Hour Plays begin the evening before the performance, when actors, writers, directors, and production staff gather for the Meet and Greet. In one hour, each person shares some insights and bring in some items that help to get the creative juices of all of the playwrights flowing. The playwrights then stay up all night writing the plays with this new creative inspiration in mind!

HOW DOES THIS WORK?

From your audience's perspective, everything will seem to go down in 24 hours, but your job starts the day you license. You'll begin pre-production, which includes: recruiting all of your participants, designers, fellow producers, etc., arranging the necessary rehearsal and performance space and choosing a day for it all to take place. Once the big day arrives, you will then embark on the 24 hour creation and rehearsal process (which is outlined in the previous two pages), before sharing the work you've made with your community! On and off-Broadway we have found success producing six ten-minute plays, but some groups choose a different number of plays to fit their community. While the entire process takes place over the course of 24 hours, the actual performance of the plays does not. A typical 24 Hour Plays production runs about 2 hours.

HOW TO LICENSE THE 24 HOUR PLAYS

Our licensing process is as fast as you are!

Steps:

- 1. Fill out a license request.
- 2.Sign your licensing agreement and pay the licensing fee.
- 3. Receive final approval and get started!

What you need to request a license:

- performance space and date (virtual is fine, and don't worry, you can make changes later!),
- ticket price and the total number of seats,
- coffee.

What you don't need to request a license:

- a full list of participants,
- a production team,
- an audience,
- any preconceived notions about how to make "good art" (because, like, what is that?)

THE 24 HOUR PLAYS FAQs

Q: What kind of technical support do I need?

A: You can produce The 24 Hour Plays with as little as overhead lighting and performance area. The production can expand or contract to fit your parameters.

Q: Does everybody have to stay up for 24 hours?

A: No! Although the entire production process lasts 24 hours, each person participates for a portion, at designated times.

Q: What if the stage is already set for another production?

A: All the better! Many productions of The 24 Hour Plays have been performed on the set for another show. Make sure the artists know what can be used and what is off-limits.

Q: Why do I need to license with you?

A: The 24 Hour Plays are a registered trademark, both our name and our proprietary producing process (say that five times fast!). Just as you would license Oklahoma! or Our Town for a production at your theater, you license The 24 Hour Plays name and process from us. Plus, you'll receive support from our NYC office, your own page on our website, and our official logo to use in your own promotions!
